Sanjay Mathur appointed Chief Economist for Southeast Asia and India

ANZ today announced that Sanjay Mathur will join as Chief Economist, Southeast Asia and India, reporting to Khoon Goh, ANZ's Head of Asia Research.

Mr Mathur was previously from Royal Bank of Scotland (RBS), where he was Head of Economics Research (Asia ex-Japan) for nearly ten years and led research teams across economics, foreign exchange, rates and credit.

Prior to RBS, he also worked at Barclays and UBS where he held a number of senior economist roles.

During his tenure at RBS, Mr Mathur published on a variety of topics including the impact of China's rebalancing on ASEAN, a comparison of reforms in India and Indonesia, and policy options for Asia in a world of slowing global trade.

ANZ's Head of Asia Research, Khoon Goh said: "Sanjay's extensive experience, deep knowledge of the Southeast Asia and India markets and quality of analysis will be highly valued by our clients. He will be an integral part of the ANZ Research team, working closely with other ANZ economists and strategists to serve our clients globally."

In this role, Sanjay will be responsible for providing macroeconomic analysis and insight on key Asian markets. Mr Mathur will commence in February, based in Singapore.
